Before this job my life was tattered with irresponsibility and short term jobs. This led to fears of failure, thoughts of inadequacy, lack of selfconfidence, and nothing to show for nearly thirty years of life; oh what a terrible demise to be in as an individual. I am so thankful God is not a respecter of persons and seeks to redeem all people. He answered my prayers and gave me a new life. Although I have much to learn as a man and a Minister of the Gospel, God as placed me on a solid foundation in Christ Jesus! Jesus you are worthy to be praised!

Thank you for giving to RE-CHRIST MINISTRIES. It has been such a rewarding and challenging experience to be a self-supported missionary for the past ten years.
