Praise the Lord for another one who has given his life over to God's grace by accepting Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. The first two months of the year have been filled with many praises of life transformation. During the first few weeks of the year, one night as I was taking our middle school students to church one young man made these comments.

"Mr. Matt I am so grateful for 24K, the place of worship and gathering for the youth at our local church, and for all the people who helped to build it. And those people, adults, who give of their time to help us learn about God, they don't get paid, do they, do they? I am so grateful people are willing to provide a safe place for me and my friends to come and hang out and learn about God. I am also grateful for the big guy, the youth pastor, who shares the Bible stories each night. I am just so thankful Mr. Matt."

These statements came from the mouth of a sixth grader who has been touched by the hand of Jesus. When we met this young man he was alone and listening to rap music but now his heart shouts for joy over the blessings of God. I was utterly delighted and filled with joy as this young man spontaneously erupted into a rejoicing sound of thanksgiving. Praise the Lord!

Also during the month of January another young man who is in our middle school program gave his life to Christ. This same young man was kicked out of the program at the end of last year for fighting. However, through his discipline he learned what he was missing and has been faithful ever sense. His faithfulness led to his decision for Christ. One Saturday night the youth were gathering at 24K, but this young man did not have a ride to church (Ashley and I were busy that night). However, his challenge was overcome by determination. The young man literally ran the three miles to church and participated in the youth event. At the end of the event, the Gospel was presented, and the young man in question gave his life to Jesus. He did not know anybody at the youth event, yet, was the first one to get up from his seat in the back of the room to make his way to the front of the room where the pastor stood waiting for anybody to respond. Through his willingness to begin attending Sunday morning services several other middle school students have started coming to church on Sunday morning as well. This past Sunday two of our middle school students completed the new believers' class at our local church and are now preparing to enter into a youth Sunday school class. Praise the Lord! Christ is contagious and influential amen! Please pray several of our students who need to get baptized. I want the Holy Spirit to convict them of what they need to do and not to feel pressured by us or anybody else in the church. This is often difficult because there is not much encouragement in the home and to be a trend setter or a generational curse buster in middle school takes courage. However, God is faithful and will complete the GREAT work HE has begun.

Mid January we were blessed to bring on our first, part time employee, Eric Humphries. Eric has been working with us over the past six weeks, supervising one of the elementary after school programs, and helping with our middle school outreach. I met Eric through my job with Apartment Life; he is one of the missionaries serving on my team at a nearby apartment community. Eric and his wife Kayla served in Israel for a couple of years before moving to Atlanta to begin working with Apartment Life. I have also seen great potential in Eric as a young missionary and it was a tremendous blessing to be able to offer him a job at the beginning of the year. He is young and energetic with a thirsting knowledge for God. Every day he sits on the floor with the kids and teaches them about God's Word and then after they complete their homework Eric loves to play games with the children on the black top area in the apartment community. Eric's appointment to our ministry in another sign of growth and I am so thankful God placed him in our pathway and provided us an additional way to help raise support for RE-CHRIST MINISTRIES via my job with Apartment Life. It is very challenging working two jobs, but this is the way God has made for us to expand our territory and for that we are blessed to walk in these challenges. None of these three young men have a male father figure in their homes. Pray for them as they are looking for understanding in this area of life.
