Thank you for your continued love and support of RE-CHRIST MINISTRIES. Over the summer we labored diligently in sharing the Gospel message in hopes many might come to know Jesus as Lord and Savior. It is our joy to persistently do what is necessary to see others come to know Jesus as the Christ. Our work is satisfying because our knowledge of Jesus grows as He works through us to accomplish His will. - July 8-10 we hosted a three night VBS with our partners at Peachtree Corners Baptist Church. We had 75 adults and children attend each night from the community and 20 servant-volunteers serve from PCBC. Each night we shared a meal, shared a Bible story, and some fun games and activities. Adults and children we prayed over, some people made a decision to accept Jesus, and a community was strengthened by God's love for all of His creations. Simple, but powerful, and effective.
- 2) Our July outreach provoked within me the idea to start a weekly worship service at the Corners Apartments. However, I had a few hurdles to overcome. One, I needed to ask for permission from the property manager of the apartment community because of fair house laws. 98% of apartment communities will say No, if we asked to have a weekly worship service. However, I felt God was in this so I proceeded. However, I needed to overcome one other obstacle as well. The obstacle was to share Jesus with the property manager who is living a homosexual lifestyle. As you might imagine I was a bit nervous thinking I might offend the property manager by sharing Jesus, but I could no longer avoid sharing God's love with him simply because I thought he might respond negatively. Even if our entire ministry at this location came crashing down this man deserved to know God loved him, accepted him, but also needed him to repent and turn to Jesus. My fears were filled with joy through my obedience to God. The property manager allowed me to start a weekly service and he was so intrigued by our conversation on eternity that he invited me to lunch again. This time he said he would pay. God's ways are trustworthy. God loves all people and sent Jesus to die so they might have life!
- 3) Chris was the emissions man who checked our cars in August. He had many thoughts on religion and spirituality, but basically he was like a dog chasing his tail. His thoughts went in a circle and served him no good. I challenged him to think about the prophecies found in the Bible. How is it that 2,500 archeological discoveries have been made concerning the Bible and not a single one contradicts the Bible's content. Biblical prophecy is a rational thought which can lead us to a right relationship with God through Jesus Christ. Chris was stumped and did not have an answer for the evidence I provided. Let's stop









thinking we are smarter than God and trust him with the 1% of faith He requires for us to have eternal life.

- 4) For my birthday in August I received a gift certificate for a massage. The massage therapist talked a lot during my massage so rather than complain I figured I would share Jesus with her. Although, she did not come to Christ at that moment she knew what I said was true. In our conversation I used personal testimonies to reveal God's love for her. Did you know the Bible is a bunch of eye witness testimony, personal accounts of Jesus? Why are eye witnesses good enough to convict criminals but not proof enough that God exist?
- 5) In August we started our weekly worship service on the tennis courts at one of the local apartment communities where we work. The first night we had about 12 adults and 20 youth and kids. Last week, week four, we had about 40 total people and added two new families. This is amazing because this is what most people in the community make of our worship service. I get texts like, "Mr. Matt what time is the thing tonight with the guy and the guitar?" These sheep need a Shepherd and we are there to teach them how to worship God. This is another mystery but truth of the Gospel message of Christ. People are attracted to His light. People want to receive His love, God wants people to receive His love. Therefore, He makes true worship appealing to those who do not even know to what it is they are attracted. Another big praise coming from the start of this worship service is one of our high school students translates for me. God is using him to provide the Spanish speaking community what I cannot do on my own.
- 6) September 2 was our kick off date concerning our after school programs and our ESL classes. We have 70 students in our after school programs and about 12 adult ESL students. Pray for us as we minister to them over the course of the school year. The blessing is that we now have been ministering long enough in the same community that we have six high school students who help us mentor our elementary students. These students have been with us since their elementary school days. Our discipleship cycle is coming full circle and people's lives are being transformed. Human transformation is the number one evidence God exist. Come to Jesus and live!
