

- We helped five different families in need this year. Each family required special attention and special provisions. God shed his light to be a miracle for each family. We work hard to really seek to provide that amazing touch of grace on the lives of specific families so that they will see the Lord lifted up high and mighty. It is amazing to see God's love at work in hurting hearts.
- I was blessed to share the Gospel with a Muslim woman, Madera, this month. Our interaction started by me offering to throw away her garbage. After doing this random deed she exclaimed how nice I was. This is where I shared how I became so nice, it's all about Jesus. She also allowed me to provide her a copy of the New Testament. I told her that her spiritual book, the Koran, said that she needed to read the New Testament. More to come....
- We shared Christ with our neighbors this Christmas as we went to several neighborhood functions. Also, one neighborhood, whose Dad died a year ago, came to us one night in need. We brought her into our home, gave her a meal, and then took her across town to help her with her need. She was so moved by our love for her she bought us tickets to a local Christmas celebration in Atlanta. Ashley and I went on a date night, yeah!
- We transported about 100 people to a church function called a Walk Thru Bethlehem using two, 12 passenger vans. We have been doing this for several years and the attendance continues to grow, but this year was special because several men came for the first time. This was huge because Hispanic men are typically off to the side. Culturally their focus is work. We provide this opportunity for families to help teach the Gospel through a different means and also to encourage families to do spiritual things together. This event is all about the family so we love to see the entire family participate.
- We witnessed two of our middle school students learn to fight against demonic influence. It is amazing to watch a 13 year old boy fight to overcome a depression that locked









him in his room for months. It is equally amazing to watch a 12 year old girl learn how to fight in the Lord to overcome the sexual abuse she endured at the age of 6.

These are just a few simple bullet point testimonies of what the Lord has recently been doing in the ministry. In no way does it capture the depths of the spiritual battles we have been fighting. We have stood in the gap for many families and individuals, going into their homes spending countless hours in prayer and counseling. We have placed others needs above our own, in order that they might see the Lord in all of His goodness and glory. We have mobilized saints into action and facilitated kingdom resources for people in need. We have witnessed 100 students sharing in God's Word each week through our outreach. We have witnessed hearts change and the ministry grow. Words can never capture what the Lord is working in us each day, week, month, and year, but we pray that somehow our update provides you a glimpse of God's work through RE-CHRIST MINISTRIES.
