For a few months now Eden has attended our Saturday morning worship services at the Youth Detention Center. Eden is a young lady who has been hurt numerous times in her life and lacks trust in almost anyone. She reveres herself with confidence even when she makes the wrong decision. She has placed spiritual walls of bitterness, resentment, and anger between her and God and others. Eden is the type of child that would not blink if she did not desire to do so. Eden is a very strong willed child but is seeking understanding and truth.

Last week at the YDC this strong willed child made the most confident and best decision she has ever made; Eden gave her life to Christ. The pastor who was preaching gave a bold alter call for anyone who wanted to accept Christ to come and stand beside him at the end of the service. Eden was the first one to respond. Several other kids came as well but to watch Eden immediately respond to God and be willing make a public testimony for the Lord before her peers was amazing.

It was as if she was reliving the biblical account the pastor had just taught. The pastor, Joe Lewis, spoke on a passage from Mark 10 where a blind man received his sight. This particular blind man would sit on the side of the street every day and beg for money, but this day he knew Jesus was coming to town and when Jesus came near him the blind man cried out, "Son of David, Son of David!" The crowd tried to quiet the blind man but Jesus instructed the very people who were trying to quiet him to go and bring him to Jesus. As the man stood to his feet to be led over to the Christ (Son of David) the blind man threw down his cloak. The blind man's cloak represented everything that he was before he met Jesus. The blind man was dependent upon his cloak for it was his cloak in which he collected his begging money every day. By throwing aside his cloak the blind man said I completely trust in you Jesus for my salvation and my new way of living. Jesus immediately restored the blind man's sight and he began to follow Jesus. Our local church has recently created an international Sunday school class and it is our hope that our English classes will be a conduit for growth in this class and our church. I love God's timing and how He moves pieces of the puzzle into place for His glory.

Tomorrow Ashley and I will be traveling to North Georgia to lead our Sunday school class on a marriage retreat. Please pray for our fellowship and martial growth. Pray that God would change us all to be more like Him so that our marriages thrive and that our children flourish with godliness for generations to come. The remainder of this year will be extremely busy for Ashley and me.
